HO. CO. 12-14 Howard County – Appointed Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board – Compensation
Submitted by the Howard County Delegation

FOR the purpose of providing that the compensation for the Howard County Appointed Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board shall be the amount set by the Howard County Council; and generally relating to the compensation of the Howard County Appointed Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board.

HO. CO. 13-14 Howard County – Practice of Massage – Regulation
Submitted by the Howard County Delegation

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Governing Body of Howard County to adopt ordinances or regulations relating to massage establishments and the practices of certain individuals; requiring the Governing Body of Howard County to provide that the Howard County Health Officer and the Howard County Police Department have certain authority to carry out certain provisions of ordinances or regulations; and generally relating to the practice of massage in Howard County.
